

What goes into The Nation's Favourite?

It all started with a simple question: "Is there a better way?"

Leisure vehicle design and construction was stagnant for over 30 years, until we developed Alu-Tech and changed everything. Alu-Tech is a completely new approach to bodyshell construction. Using a unique interlocking aluminium framework to clamp the body panels together, Bailey created a shell that is more robust and durable than anything else on the market.

By significantly reducing the number of external joints and fixing points and using timber-free components in the upper bodyshell panels, we are able to provide greater protection against the elements. Thicker, better-insulated panels, cloaked in impact resistant GRP (Glass Reinforced Plastic), hugely improve the thermal performance of the bodyshell, for genuine four-season performance. All this with no increase in weight or cost. Turns out there really is a better way.

Like our cold chamber testing, which goes down to -15°C to get the best possible results in thermal insulation with the help of our heating system partners.
